

Privacy Notice – Use of Biometric Data

Use of Biometric Data

Discovery Educational Trust (DET) and its Schools use biometric data to provide cashless payment for school meals and to manage library accounts. The information used is an identifying code based on a scan of a fingerprint, with pupil name, school year, and class name. A fingerprint scan is checked against available funds in the payment account to enable the purchase of school meals, and a deduction is made from payment accounts. Additionally, fingerprint scans record the booking out and checking in of library items updating the library system.

This information is shared with the DET/School system provider, who works for DET/its Schools under contract. Each DET School is the Data Controller. The legal basis for using personal data for this purpose is Explicit Consent. As reliance is placed on your consent, you can withdraw consent at any time by contacting the relevant School Office.

This information is deleted when the pupil leaves the School, or when consent to use it is withdrawn.

No personal information is routinely available outside of the UK. Should a transfer of personal information be necessary, DET/its Schools only do so where it is permitted by law, and where appropriate safeguards are in place.
